Here they are committed to sustainably farming their 31 acres of mostly Merlot vines, situated at the top of the south-facing clay and limestone plateau of picturesque St.-emilion. BARDE-HAUT was among those elevated to Grand Cru Classe in the St.-emilion classification of 2012. Bordeaux isn't the first region you think of when it comes to values, yet the 2012 vintage was tricky, with October rains favoring the earlier-ripening Merlot. Thus, Graves, Pessac-Leognan, Pomerol and St.-emilion had the advantage, relying more heavily on Merlot in the blends. Here are three bottlings that find good balance and expression of the vintage.
